- 1. Emergency Plan:

- 2. Current Centerville Math Data
  - a. Shared by Amy Wright.
    - i. In K-3 Are growth for last year was great.
    - ii. In SAGE testing (3-6) Our scores show that the students' growth is growing from year to year.
    - iii. We are currently typical in our growth. We would like to show exemplary growth for the year 2022.
    - iv. It is not okay that only half of our students are proficient.
- 3. Current Centerville Language Arts Data
  - a. Our goal is to have 10% on RISE (4-6) and Acadience LA testing (k-3) as per 2022 End of Year Assessments compared to 2022.
    - i. We are progress monitoring every other week.
    - ii. At the end of the year, we had 57% proficient.
    - iii. 55.4% of students are reading above grade level. We want all students to make above average growth.
    - iv. We are focusing on strong tier 1 teaching. We will be focusing on whole group instruction.
  - b. We will revisit testing in the middle of the year.
- 4. Mrs. Bertram would like to create a committee to help get students enrolled in kindergarten next year. Mrs. Bertram would like to meet with families and get them access to Waterford Learning.
  - a. We have lots of students here on variance.
